The Weather Outside Was Frightful, But My Dear The Los Angeles Chapter Coronation Was So Delightful!





Introducing San Diego Queen-Elect Lucie Bilyavska by Lucie Bilyavska



I migrated to the U.S as a citizen of the Ukraine, even though I was born in Russia on the Island of Sakhalin. Growing up, I travelled extensively as both my father and husband were military officers with frequent orders for a transfer to new duty stations.

While I grew up in Minsk, the capital of Belorussia (now Belarus), my dad eventually moved our family to Moscow, where, as a child, I studied three years of ballet,

which laid the foundation for what would become a lifetime hobby and a love for dancing.

In addition, when I was ten years old, I learned to play piano in Russia with three years of Music Education. This helped my dance career by providing me with a good feel for musical rhythms.

Later in life, my five years of study at the Linguistic University, specializing in both the English and French languages, enabled me to always find work in whatever city I relocated to, either as a teacher, interpreter, or translator.

After my marriage ended in 1997, I moved to Prague, in the Czech Republic, with my 17-year-old son Roman, to start a new life.

During the day, I worked giving basic lessons in English to Russians of all ages. In the evening, I would “dance the night away.”

Over a 16-year period, my love of dancing and competitions had me moving back and forth, every four years, from Prague to Rome. During the eight years I lived in Rome, my Chinese partner and I, dancing Am-Am, competed in Europe in the highest-level Senior, International Standard, and 5-dance competitions, with much success. Sometimes there were 70-80 other amateur couples competing against us. Regardless, God blessed our efforts as we consistently finished “top 3” in almost every competition!

Truly, for me, dancing is synonymous with happiness, which, by the way, only increased when I emigrated to live in America. For it was here that I discovered and embraced an entirely new dance life (which was totally different from the European Amateur Competitions). As a result, I am now totally immersed in doing Showcases and Pro-Am Competitions.

For example, with Chuck DiSessa I’ve danced a “Beauty and the Beast” choreography on stage in summer theater with The San Diego Follies, and we performed it again for Shirley McCloskey’s Coronation ceremony. Additionally, I will often be seen performing in competitions at the local hotels for events like “Beach Bash,” which was hosted by Jonathan Roberts, Michael Meade and his wife, Toni Redpath, and “The Great Gatsby,” hosted by Kasia Kozak and others, as well as performing in local, studio Showcase events.

In fact, in my first Pro-Am Showcase at Mary Murphy’s Champion Ballroom Academy, I was honored to win the “Best of Show” award with my instructor, Jason Rivers.

To this day, I strive to grow and develop my dancing talent and technique, and I look forward to doing more competitions and showcases. Audiences have enjoyed Pro-Am showcases that I have danced with both Jason Rivers and David Fan, as we entertained them with performances of “The Kalinka,” based on the very popular Russian Folk Dance, and “The Nutcracker,” a very beautiful Ukrainian dance which I recently performed at the San Diego Smooth Dancers’ Christmas Showcase.

In closing, I am thrilled to represent the San Diego Chapter as their Queen-elect for 2023. (Outside the U.S., only “The Royalty” have this honor!) On a personal level, when I think of having my own Coronation, I am overwhelmed with so much emotion over the idea that I get to be a part of such a beautiful and solemn ceremony, in all its tradition and elegance, which only exists here in California within our NSD organization.

My heartfelt gratitude goes out to all those who make this possible for me, and I look forward to meeting many of you at my Coronation and then seeing you again at your Coronations later in the year.


